

CCI supplies cables for India's first F1 race track

Cable Corp of India Ltd (CCI), bagged the cable supply order from Noida-based Jaypee Sports International (JPSI) over global and domestic competition for India's first Formula One race track at the Buddh International Circuit in Greater Noida, finished installation of the 230 KV cable system. The first event of India's Grand Prix was held during October as the 17th race of 2011 Formula One Season. The total turnkey contract envisages a supply of approx 8 km of 1x800 sq mm aluminum conductor XLPE Insulated cable, straight thru joints, outdoor termination kits along with allied material. The track designed by German racetrack designer Hermann Tilke is the second fastest circuit in world with top speed of about 318 km/h. ■
